This Advanced Apprenticeship in Barbering Level 3 is suitable for anyone who has already taken a similar qualification at level 2 such as barbering or hairdressing or for those with substantial experience in the industry.

This qualification is appropriate for the role of senior barber.

Duration of the Course - 21 months

Mandatory Units

- Provide shaving services
- Provide hairdressing consultation services
- Design and create a range of facial hair shapes
- Creatively cut hair using a combination of barbering techniques

Optional Units

- Colour & lighten mens hair
- Perm & Neutralise hair
- Design & create patterns in hair
- Provide a variety of relaxing services

Other Apprenticeship Requirements

- Personal Learning & Thinking Skills (PLTS), ERR Workbook and Functional Skills L2 in English & Maths

Course Structure

To achieve the **Intermediate Apprenticeship in Barbering Level 2**, learners must achieve **66** credits in total; **40** credits from the mandatory units and a total of **26** credits from the optional units. From the optional units, you will be able to select those that are most appropriate to your job role.

Progression

On successful completion of this qualification, you may wish to progress to another qualification appropriate to your personal development. There are also privately funded qualifications available e.g. Award in Education and Training Level 3 or Training Assessment & Quality Assurance (TAQA) Level 3 & 4.
