Course Structure

To achieve the **BTEC Certificate in Management Level 5**, learners must achieve **23** credits in total; **14** credits from the mandatory units and a total of **9** credits from the optional units. From the optional units, you will be able to select those that are most appropriate to your job role.

To achieve the **BTEC Diploma in Management Level 5**, learners must achieve **39** credits in total; **20** credits from the mandatory units and a total of **19** credits from the optional units. From the optional units, you will be able to select those that are most appropriate to your job role.

Progression

Once you have successfully completed your Level 5 qualification, you may wish to progress to another qualification appropriate to your personal development.

There are also privately funded qualifications you may wish to consider e.g. Award in Education and Training Level 3 or Training Assessment & Quality Assurance (TAQA) Level 3 and 4.
