- All units within the mandatory qualification
- Functional skills at the required level and work towards achieving a higher level
- Pass through the gateway ensuring the learner is ready for the end point assessment
- End point assessment

On successful completion of this qualification, you may wish to progress to senior hair professional in Hairdressing Level 3 or another qualification appropriate to your personal development.
