COURSE INFORMATION

This Advanced and Creative Hair Professional Apprenticeship in Hairdressing Level 3 is designed for people who have been working in the hairdressing industry for at least 18 months and are looking to move into a higher qualified role.

This qualification could be appropriate for jobs such as:

- Stylist or Hairdresser
- Session Stylist
- Salon Owner
- And further career options

Duration of the Course - 18 months

- Creatively restyle hair using a combination of techniques
- Creatively style and dress hair
- Creative hair colour correction services
- Provide client consultation services
- Smoothing and strengthening systems
- Use fashion forward trends in hair to create a collection of hairstyle looks

Course Structure

To achieve the Advanced and Creative for Hair professionals in hairdressing Level 3 Apprenticeship , learners must achieve the following;

- All units within the mandatory qualification
- Maths and English Functional skills at level 2.
- Pass through the gateway ensuring the learner is ready for the end point assessment.
- End point assessment Knowledge Exam
- End point assessment Practical & Oral Questioning Exam
- Collection of Images Portfolio

Progression

Once you have successfully completed your Level 3 qualification, you may wish to progress to another qualification appropriate to your personal development i.e. Customer Service or Management.

There are also privately funded qualifications you may wish to consider e.g. Award in Education and Training Level 3 or Training Assessment & Quality Assurance (TAQA) Level 3 and 4.
